The club will provide interesting breads/rolls to accompany along with beer/wine/soda & since this is winter possibly coffee/tea/cocoa.


Directions: Take Interstate 75 North to Exit 329 towards Wildwood. Head East on 44 towards Leesburg for about 5 miles (cross HY 301). Turn left, North, on Buena Vista Blvd (at a traffic light). Drive about

2 miles, cross HY 466a and enter The Villages, stay on Buena Vista. Continue North for another ½ mile and at the traffic circle exit Left (West) on St Charles Place (entering the Village of St Charles). Use either gate as they are not controlled. Continue on St Charles Place for about 2 miles. Turn Left on Buttonwood Run. After 100 yards, turn right on Queen Palm Pl. After 100 yards turn Left on Rolling Oak Ave. (2nd road). Go to end of street then turn Left on Fringe Tree Trail. We are the first house on the right, next to the open lots.

FYI from the editor - Google maps on your computer does not find their street. The map to the right is from MapQuest. On my iPhone the app for MapQuest also will find the directions but the built in map for the iPhone does not. So you might want to test your car/phone/hand held GPS before you leave.


After our hour tour we retrieved our MB for various parking lots and headed a couple miles across St. Peters-


