**Details:** While Tullius is a racing hero who founded the legendary Group 44 racing team almost 50 years ago, he doesn't live in Sebring for its racing history. Instead, he's there because of the love for airplanes he discovered in the late 1960s. While his love for sports car racing and team ownership decreased over the years, his interest in planes grew significantly. Over the past few decades, he's owned a wide range of planes. That includes one of the most soughtafter exotics: the P-51 Mustang, a single-seat fighter-bomber used during World War II and the Korean War. Tullius also maintains another half a dozen planes in his private hangar, as well as several of Group 44's race cars.

Dinner at Yianni's Restaurant will follow our tour around 1:45 PM. they have early Sunday special dinners from \$7.99t o 9.99 (this is not a typo!!) that include choice of potato, vegetable, fresh baked roll and glass of wine or draft beer!! An additional glass of wine is \$2.50! They also have extensive regular menu and a 5 star rating on many sites.

The board will have a suite at the Marriott for both Saturday & Sunday night (BTW Monday the 21st is MLK birthday and may be an off day for those of you who still work). Standard queen & king rooms are \$121 & \$131 and the 2 bedroom/2 bath suites are \$161/nite - easy to share with 2 couples. All have full kitchens and come with full hot buffet

breakfast. Plenty of room to party in the suites where the club will provide the usual libations and snacks. Jo Ann & Jim can also provide golf course information for those who want to come early on Saturday or stay longer on Monday to play. Contact them if you are interested.

**Details:** Step out from under the hot Florida sun to discover how the cool, crisp taste of Yuengling is brewed and bottled. Tour the Yuengling brewery in Tampa where "America's Oldest Brewery" uses modern technology to brew fine beer in a time-honored tradition. Sample the Yuengling heritage for yourself at the brewery's biergarten.

- Yuengling tour guides will share with you history of the brewery and detailed information regarding the brewing process, however there is no production on Saturday's.
- Tours last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes.
- All ages are welcome. A valid ID is required to sample Yuengling products at the end of the tour. There is soda available for those under the age of 21 and visitors who prefer non-alcoholic beverages.
- All tour visitors must wear completely closed shoes. No sandals, flip flops, clogs, crocks, anything with openings around your foot is unacceptable, **must be a completely closed shoe.**
- The building is not handicapped accessible.

**MiMi's Cafe:** In 1944, an American airman named Arthur J. Simms fell in love with the beauty, foods and flavors of France. It was to become a passion that would change his life.

Stationed there during the final days of World War II, young Arthur J. was taken by the friendly neighborhood bistros and warm, inviting cafés. Arthur J. loved the simple yet charming meals. He savored the aroma of freshly baked breads, café au lait and the company of good friends raising toasts all around. Equally captivating was a mademoiselle he met by chance, who went by the name of Mimi. Arthur J. Simms never forgot his days in France. In 1978, he opened the first Mimi's Cafe® – a neighborhood bistro inspired by his memories of Mimi and passion for good food, wine and camaraderie that he remembered so fondly.


